CONDUCT OF BUSINESS:

Salmon Restoration Association - July 1st Salmon BBQ

Michael Miller of the Salmon Restoration Association asked the Commissioners for an explanation of the new 10% user fee they have imposed. Vice Chair Dillion explained the District is bringing fees and services up to date with other harbors and feels it is fair and equitable.

A lengthy debate followed with SRA members Paul Tichinin, Michael Miller, Cynthia Scott and members of the audience and the Commission regarding the fee increase reasons, pros and cons. The SRA is in protest of the increase, and they would like to form an ad hoc committee to research other harbors and their fees and return to discuss this at the next meeting. Commissioner Forkner said he feels that in general better communication and interaction with the Harbor and everyone would be a good thing going forward and all were invited to attend future Harbor meetings. The Commission would like to take more time to discuss this among themselves and revisit the matter with the full Commission in attendance.

Staff was directed to continue the item on the next agenda for further discussion.
